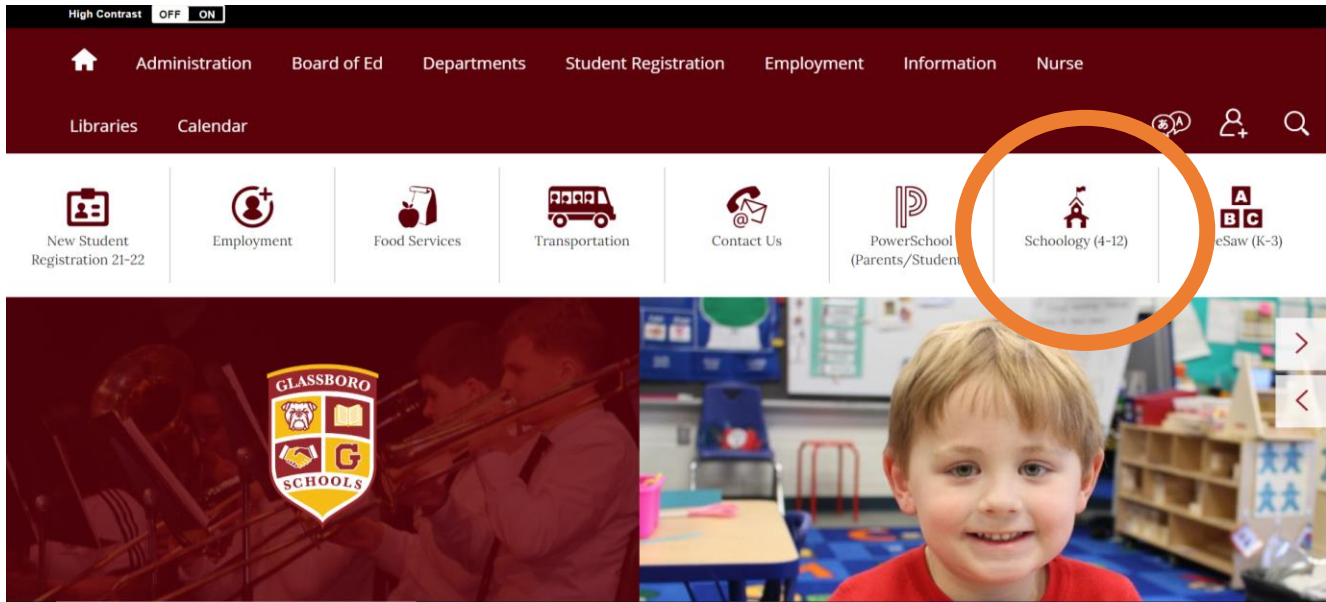

Special Area Course instructions are detailed on page 6.

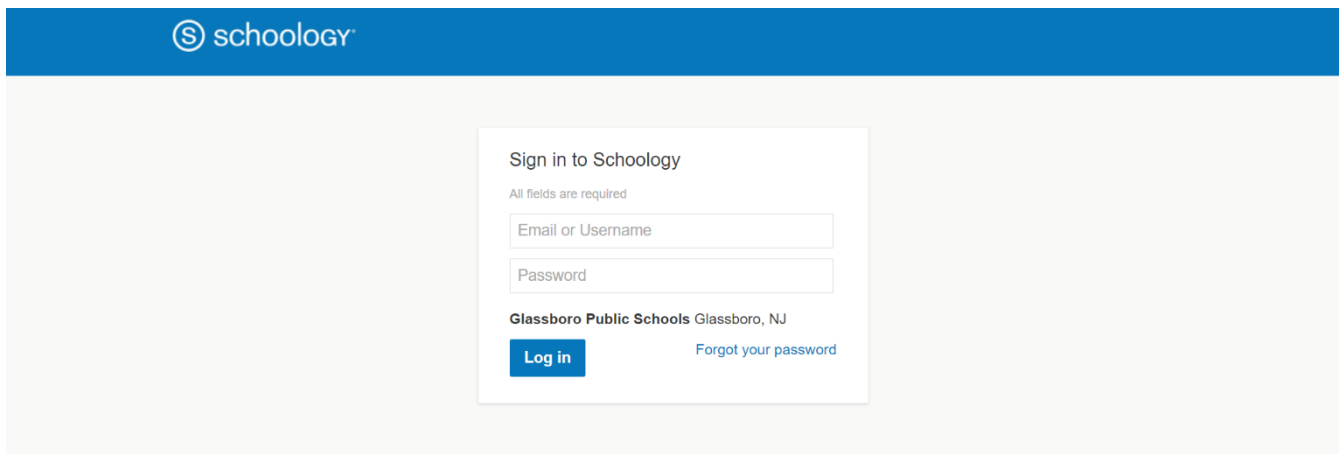
Excluded students due to quarantine need to report to classes virtually, or they will be marked absent.

How to use Schoology for Online Class Sessions starting 9/23/2021

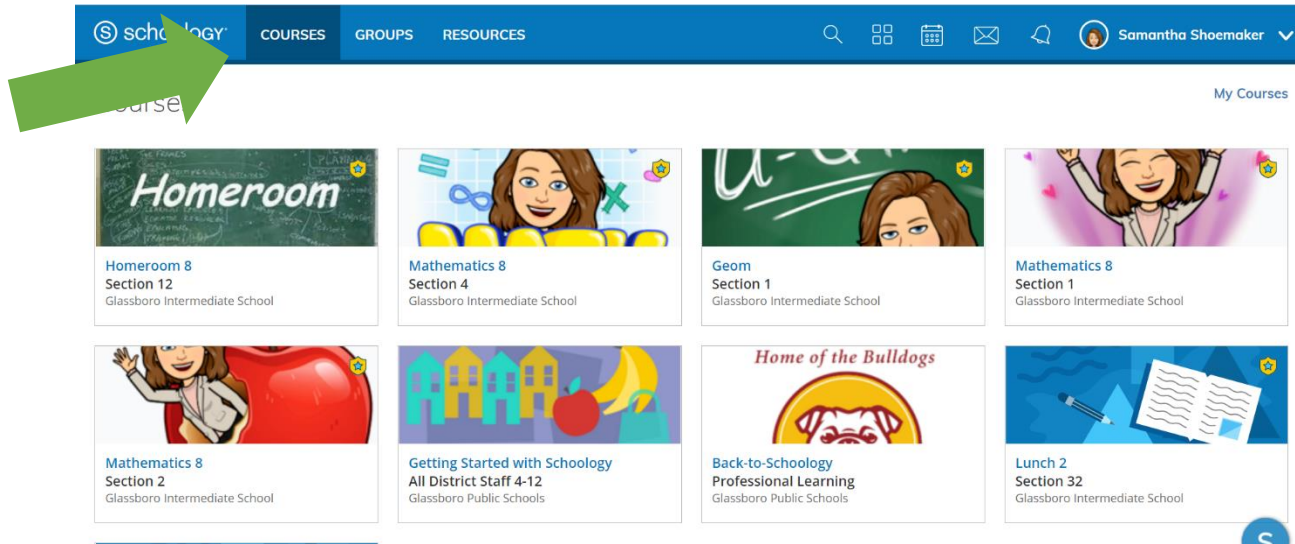
1.) Click on the Schoology link located on the Glassboro Public School District website. The website link is <https://www.gpsd.us/>



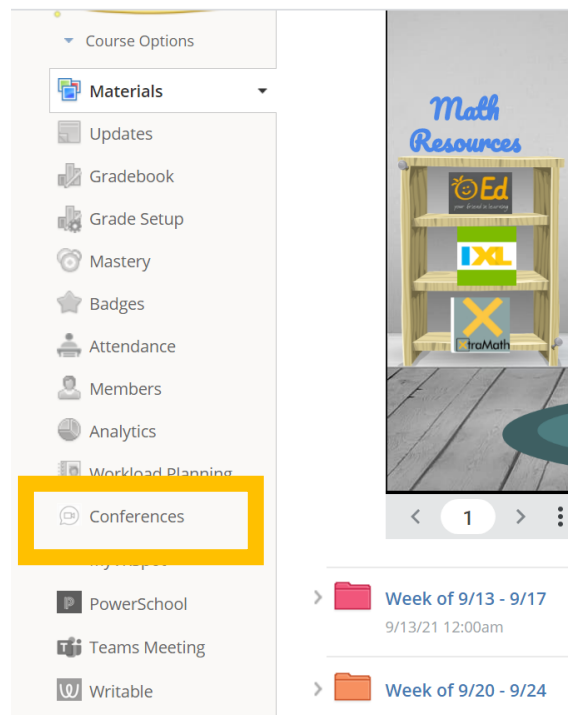
2.) Log in to Schoology. If you have difficulties please email Sue Kornicki: Skornicki@gpsd.us regarding usernames / passwords.




3.) Once logged into Schoology locate the COURSES option on the top of screen. All courses that a student is enrolled into this school year will be located here. Select the course you are needing to join for class.



4.) Once in the selected course, locate the CONFERENCES option on the left side of the screen.




5.) Once in the Conferences, join the class that is in session. This will be indicated with an **In progress** status, as noted in the image below.
