### **CORONAVIRUS (COVID-2019)**

At Inspira Health, we are committed to keeping you informed about the new coronavirus (COVID-19) that originated in Wuhan, China in December 2019.

Our clinical leadership teams continue to closely monitor the situation and put procedures in place to protect patients, visitors and staff should a person — who meets current criteria for suspicion of COVID-19 — visit an Inspira facility. Our facilities are following the most current guidance provided by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and local health authorities to appropriately screen, isolate and manage patients who meet the criteria.

Anyone with cold or flu-like symptoms should seek care as they normally would, immediately alerting the health care facility or health care provider if they have traveled to the affected areas within the past 30 days; or have been in close contact with someone who has been under investigation for, or is a confirmed case of, COVID-19. Anyone concerned that they or a loved one might be displaying clinical distress (such as breathing difficulties) should call 9-1-1 as they normally would.

### **Visitor Restrictions**

For the safety of our patients and staff there will be no visitors allowed at this time, except: Maternity patients are limited to 1 visitor. For the safety of our maternity patients and staff, you cannot visit if you:

- are presently ill (with fever, cough)
- recently traveled to countries listed in the CDC travel alerts
- are under the age of 18
- are presently a person under investigation for COVID -19
- have had any contact with individuals who are confirmed to be a "person under investigation" for coronavirus

For patients who are at the end of life, we will exercise flexibility in number and age for visitors during this difficult time.

Exceptions may be made for specific cases with the approval of Administration.
