

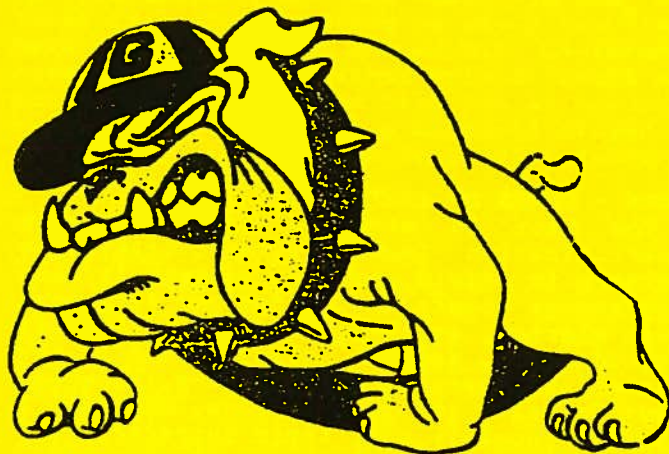

HALL OF FAME INDUCTEES 1991

BARBARA FANFARILLO CASSADAY - CLASS OF 1957

Barbara typifies the best in athletic and scholastic excellence as well as participation in school activities. She receive nine varsity letters in field hockey, basketball and softball and earned All Conference honors twice for her fine work as a goal tender. She was elected as the team Captain in all three sports during her senior year. She was also elected by her class to serve as the Class secretary for three years, she was secretary for the Student Council for three years. She was a member of the National Honor Society and their secretary for three years. Barbara has remained very active in the community with her involvement in the Boro Park & Recreatin activities and for the more than 20 years has been an officer of the Glassboro Little League.

HALL OF FAME CONT.....

SEAN REDMAN - CLASS OF 1985

Sean was the most honored athlete ever at Glassboro High School earning nine varsity letters. In track, Sean set the school record in the 400 meters and the 100 meters. The highlight of his track career was his first place finish in the State Group I meet in the 400 meter race, earning All State Group I honors. In basketball he was the senior leader on one of our best basketball teams. That year the team finished with a 26-2 record, a second place finish in the Group I tournament and a No.4 rating in the Courier-Post. Sean's speed and ballhandling skills made it near impossible for any opponent to effectively full court press our team. But it was in football that Sean really excelled. He led his team to a 9-2 record and a second place finish in the South Jersey Group I tournament as a senior. In his junior year he was one fo the leaders in our Group I Championship undefeated team. His football stats are amazing, 62 career touchdowns, over 4,000 yards gained and a near State record of almost 2,000 yds gained in one season. In 1984 he led the State in scoring with 200 points. He earned just about every honor available but we were most proud of his being named the State Athlete of the Month and his becoming Glassboro's first All State, All Groups football player. He was also named the Philadelphia Inquirer offensive player of the Year, and the Inquirer's Male Athlete of the Year. He was the Touchdown Club's Back of the Year. Sean worked hard in the classroom and earned a scholarship to Penn State where he was a member of their National Championship team and graduated in 1990. Sean is now employed as a Drug Abuse counselor for the Salem School District and a counselor for Ranch Hope.

GREG SAWYER - CLASS OF 1973

Greg was a three sport performer, earning eight varsity letters in football, wrestling and baseball. In football he was an outstanding lineman, earning All Conference honors twice and in his senior year was named to the All South Jersey Group I first team. In wrestling he was a two time District Champion as a heavyweight and also earned All Conference honors two years. His record of 16 wins against only 3 losses as a junior and 19-1 as a senior was the best we have had at heavyweight. Greg also earned two varsity letters as a baseball player. He was a fine defensive player and feared as a long ball hitter, earning All Conference honors as a senior.

JAMES BELL - CLASS OF 1951

Jim was an outstanding all around athlete at Glassboro high earning varsity letters in football, wrestling and track. In football, Jim was a lineman and thus did not receive the attention that backs receive but he earned a reputation as an outstanding blocker and an aggressive hard hitting tackler. His speed off the ball often put him in the other teams backfield where he disrupted their offense. Because of his speed he was asked by the coaches to return punts and kickoffs. For his efforts he earned All South Jersey First team honors as well as All Group II honors. Jim used his speed to excell on the track. He concentrated his efforts in the 100 yard dash, the 220 yd dash and the shot put. In the early 50's there weren't All Conference or All South Jersey teams and Jim did not receive the honors that athletes of the 70's, 80's and 90' received but he was an outstanding team leader. Mr. Bell currently resides in Vineland and has been employed by Lobiondo Brothers Trucking for more than 25 years.
