## GLASSBORO HIGH SCHOOL 2009--2010 STUDENT PARKING INFORMATION

## Dear Student:

All students with parking privileges will park in the lot next to the football stadium. All seniors and juniors (2011) with Gold Cards for the first, second and third marking periods during the 2008-09 school year are also eligible to receive a GHS parking permit. All students must have a legal driers license, proof of insurance and a legal car registration. All students desiring to drive to school must read and complete the GHS rules and regulations for student parking and complete the automobile registration form.

Parking permits will be issued on a first come first serve basis. Any student who desires to drive to school and who is not issued a permit because the lot is full will be placed on a waiting list. It is important to remember that **parking on school property is a student privilege, not a student right.** As such, there are factors that could cause your parking privilege to be revoked. Please take note of some key points relating to driving to school and parking.

- 1. No one on probation or restriction will be issued a parking permit. Permits will be revoked if a student is placed on probation or restriction.
- 2. Car trouble is an unacceptable excuse for being late to school.
- 3. Five (5) lateness or five (5) unexcused absences to school will result in not only discipline referral, but also a loss of parking privileges for the year.
- 4. Any out of school suspension will result in a loss of parking privileges for one month.
- 5. Use of a vehicle to leave school grounds at an unauthorized time will result in:
  - a. 1<sup>st</sup> offense suspension of parking privileges for three months.
  - b. 2<sup>nd</sup> offense suspension of parking privileges for the remainder of the school year.
- 6. Illegally parked cars on school property will result in:
  - a. 1<sup>st</sup> offense ticket warning, call to parent and Saturday school.
  - b. 2<sup>nd</sup> offense car will be towed at the owner's expense.
  - Underclassmen who park illegally on school grounds will not be issued a parking permit in their senior year until five (5) days before classes start in their senior year.
- 7. Driving a vehicle in such a manner to cause a safety issue will result in loss of parking privileges.
- 8. Juniors who are issued a parking permit will forfeit their permit if they fail to earn a Renaissance card during any marking period in their junior year.

## 2009-2010 RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR STUDENT PARKING

- 1. Seniors who desire to drive must complete all the information on the attached card and return it to the assistant principal along with <u>a copy of their driver's license, registration and insurance card on one page.</u>
- 2. All vehicles registered for authorized parking must carry liability and property damage insurance.
- 3. Each car must have the parking permit properly displayed and clearly visible. Permits are to be placed on the rear view mirror facing the windshield.
- 4. Students <u>must</u> park in the student parking area and only in their assigned parking spot. If someone is in your assigned spot <u>DO NOT</u> take the next spot. Report it to the main office along with a description of the vehicle and license plate number.
- 5. A ten mile per hour speed limit is enforced at all times. All other posted limits, lanes, markings and signs must be observed at all times.
- 6. Students are not to occupy or congregate around cars except upon arrival and departure from school.
- 7. Student drivers must leave school grounds immediately upon dismissal.
- 8. All cars must be locked to insure safety against theft or property loss while on school grounds. The student driver bears full responsibility for any such left or loss.
- 9. Student drivers are not permitted to take underclassmen out of the building for **ANY** reason unless approved by the administration.
- 10. Student drivers are responsible for the conduct of passengers and the contents of their vehicle while on school grounds. Any contents such as alcohol, drugs, etc. will be considered personal possession and administrative and other action will be taken where appropriate.
- 11. Parking privileges are extended based on good behavior and adherence to the above rules. Violation of these rules and/or other policies will result in disciplinary action to include suspension and/or forfeiture of the privilege of parking on school grounds.
- 12. Students on disciplinary probation or restriction are not permitted to park on school grounds.
