## **ATTENDANCE**

Any student attending Glassboro High School who exceeds five (5) **unexcused absences** in a semester forfeits the opportunity to gain course credits for all classes attempted. However, students may attend Credit Recovery (CR) in effort to earn credit for unexcused absences. A total of five (5) school days may be made-up. For each unexcused absence, a student must attend two (2) credit recovery sessions. The number of days in which a student is able to schedule Credit Recovery (CR) is limited. Therefore, administration strongly encourages students to schedule and attend CR within thirty days of exceeding eight (8) unexcused school days.

NOTE - Due to COVID-19, Credit Recovery is being offered virtually during Open Classroom sessions. To schedule CR, please contact Mr. Lynch - CLynch@gpsd.us or your guidance counselor.
